

Christmas Food Baskets

Lake Hills will provide food baskets for needy families this Christmas season. We will send our baskets to the South Knoxville Community Center, South Doyle Middle School and Mt. Place the items in a sturdy box or laundry basket. (No bags please!) Insert a note with your name so we will know whose baskets we have received. We ask that the items in the baskets be non-perishable. **Please have your baskets at the church by Sunday, December 16.**

If anyone would like to participate with monetary contributions just place a check in the offering plate (memo Christmas Baskets) and we will use your donation toward the purchase of perishable food.

The Outreach Committee will need help delivering the baskets. If you would like to help deliver, please indicate this on the sign-up sheet. **The baskets will be delivered during the afternoons of Thursday, Dec. 20 and Friday, Dec. 21.** We will also need volunteers to bag the fresh items and load the baskets. Items to Include in food baskets:

- 3 cans green beans or any green vegetable
 - 1 large bottle or can of juice
 - 3 cans corn
 - 1 bag of apples
 - 2 cans cranberry sauce
 - 1 dessert mix (cake, icing, etc.)
 - 1 box stuffing mix
 - 2-3 pkgs jello or pudding
 - 1 pkg dried beans
 - 1 jar peanut butter
 - 3 cans potatoes or 1 box instant potatoes
 - 1 jar jelly
 - 3-4 cans soup
 - 2 cans tuna
